Words from Pastor Shiu Ming Lau (Senior Pastor)



"Even though darkness covers the earth, it is still no match for a little light."

The disciple Peter said to Jesus, "Lord, you have the way of eternal life; who should I follow?" Following the Lord is not only the Lord's expectation but also the disciple's desire. The church is not like a business enterprise. The church is a spiritual home. Although we are doing similar chores every day, every month, every year in the house, the goal of a home is for each family member to grow mature, healthy, and happy.

In the same way, a church may have some goals and year-round plans every year. However, the most profound goal remains unchanged, "We shall become faithful disciples of the Lord." Discipleship is our goal; faithfulness, as an adjective, is our quantifiable indicator. And the mission is to serve the Lord Jesus, our Savior. Our discipleship is not to please people but to please the Lord.

Last year (2021), we felt fear due to the pandemic. Thank God for His faithfulness is so great that while we are facing the adversity, He has blessed the church incredibly that the work of God will continues, and the gospel continues to spread. Last year, we were quarantined at home for many months. In June, the city finally allowed the markets to resume business activities. Many shops

reopened, restaurants were allowed for indoor dining, and church worship was allowed to restart. In early July, Our English ministry took the lead in starting in-person and live-stream worship services. The Mandarin ministry also resumed in early August, and the Cantonese ministry finally resumed in the middle of the same month. We also restarted the Kids Worship in mid-September. We thank God again that, on the average, the combined in-person and live-stream worship counts are over 200 people, a reflection that the congregation members have not forgotten the essentials of our church life. Indeed, even during hardship, we cannot give up worshiping God because only He is the source of our strength, the ever-present help in life. In addition, although the pandemic is raging, it has prompted changes in the church. During the pandemic, most of our pastoral staff and the lay leaders have learned to use technology and network (at least I am one of them) to lead Bible studies, Sunday schools, and even hold different training courses. The church's baptism class and confirmation class (i.e., believer maturity class) were taught and completed in their entirety from July to December last year without delay as the result of the guarantine. Thank the Lord, we experienced the Lord's harvest on the Sunday after Christmas last year (the last Sunday of the year), and we presented all the believers and new members as fruits of grace before the Lord's throne. A total of 17 of our brothers and sisters were baptized, and 21 were confirmed as members of the church. We praise to God.

Last year our church theme was to focus on "Walking with the Holy Spirit during the Pandemic." Let's review the four subtopics: "Discern the spirits," "Disclose the Spiritual Realm," "Discover the



Spiritual gifts," and "Drench in the Fullness of the Spirit." In my sermon preaching and sharing, I reminded brothers and sisters that walking in the Holy Spirit is not an extreme charismatic or mystical experience of the Holy Spirit. It is the new life that experiences the guidance of the Holy Spirit, who inspires us to know the Bible and to value the Word of God. The Holy Spirit leads us to better understand

Christ-centered lives and grace in His Word. During the pandemic, people were panicked. At this time, some extremist sects used eschatological arguments to urge people to pursue the mysterious experience of the Holy Spirit. However, they do not know that Jesus is the hope of humankind, including his promised salvation and eternal life. I ask the Lord to continue to lead us to build up the core values that were restored from the church since the Reformation Era.

At this moment, we look back on last year's ministry with gratitude. God shows us once again that He is a faithful and trustworthy God. No matter how dark it is, it cannot block the light of God. Remember what Jesus said: "I am the light of the world, and whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12). Dear children of God, let us be touched by the Lord and shine like lights in the world, without blemish amid a crooked and twisted generation, to show hope to the darkness and despair of the community. This is the mission of the disciples.

主任牧者的話(劉少銘牧師)



「黑暗雖籠罩 大地,仍不敵 一點光輝」

門徒彼得對耶穌說:「主啊,你有永生之道,我還跟從誰呢?」跟隨主不只是主的期望,也 是門徒的渴望。教會不像商界企業,教會是屬靈的家,雖然,家中每天,每月,每年,都要做相同 和相似的事,但家的目標是要每位家中成員成長得成熟、健康、幸福和快樂。同理,教會可能每年 都定下一些目標和全年計劃。然而,最深層的目標仍然沒有改變,「我們要成為主忠信的門徒」門 徒是我們的本位; 忠信作為形容詞,是我們的可量化的指標。而對象是主耶穌,為我們的救主而做, 不單為取悅別人,而要討主喜悅。

去年(2021年)在病毒恐慌之中平安渡過了。感謝上帝、祂的信實極其廣大、在逆境中仍然大大賜福教會、使各樣聖工繼續活動、福音繼續拓展開來。去年、經過多月的居家隔離、市政府終於在6月讓市面恢復商業活動、商舗重開;餐廳終於可以有堂食;而教會聚會也最終在6月允許重啟。7月初,英文組率先開始實體和直播崇拜聚會。國語組也在8月初恢復;粵語組也在8月在中旬重新

開始實體和直播聚會。最後兒童實体崇拜也在 9 月中恢復。我們再次感謝上帝,大致上,實體和收看直播崇拜人數平均加起來也超過 200 人。這反映出會友未忘初心,重視崇拜聚會。真的,在極艱難之中,我們也不能放棄敬拜上帝,因為只有祂是我們力量的泉源,生命中隨時的幫助。另外,疫情雖然肆虐,卻而促使教會變革,很多同工和信徒領袖,也在疫情中學會用科技網絡 (至少我是其中一位)帶領查經,主日學,甚至舉辦不同的訓練。教會的洗禮班和堅振禮班 (即信徒成長班) 也從去年 7 月起至 12 月,透過網絡,完成所教的課程,沒有受病毒隔離所誤。感謝主,我們在去年聖誕後主日 (最後一個主日)中經歷主的豐收,我們把所有信主新葡和加入教會的會眾如蒙恩果子獻呈在主的寶座前。我們一共有 17 位弟兄姊妹接受洗禮和 21 位接受堅振班,成為教會一份子。我們滿心讚美上帝。



去年教會的主題為「疫有轉機,聖靈同行」。 讓我們重溫這幾個分題:「分辨諸靈、禱求聖靈、發展恩賜、靈裡豐盛」。我在講道分享中,提醒弟兄姊妹聖靈同行不是一種極端靈恩式或神祕式的聖靈體驗。而是一起經歷生命的聖靈,祂啟發我們認識聖經,重視上帝的話語。我們被聖靈引導,更能從祂的話語中看懂基督為中心和認識恩

典的道理。在疫情恐慌之際,人心惶惶。這時,一些極端教派就用末世論調促使人在追求聖靈中神祕的經歷。然而,他們卻不曉得,耶穌才是人類的盼望,包括祂所應許的救恩和永生福份。我求主繼續引領我們建立起教會復原運動所回歸的核心價值。

此刻,我們回顧去年的事工,心中充滿感恩。上帝再一次向我們顯明祂是信實可靠的上帝。無論天有多黑,上帝的光絕不會被阻隔。記得耶穌所說:「我是世上的光,跟隨我的就不在黑暗裡走,必要得着生命的光。」(約翰福音 8:12) 各位光明的兒女們,讓我們被主所感動,如明光照耀,把基督的光輝照亮在黑暗絕望的社群之中。這是門徒的使命。

2021 年粵語組聖工和活動匯報

崇拜:

- 1) 去年度主題:「疫有轉機,聖靈同行」我們用教會講壇教導幾個重要分題:「分辨諸靈, 禱求聖靈,發展恩賜,靈裡豐盛」有兩點值得檢討的地方,第一,在發展恩賜這主題上, 教會沒有在實踐上指導信徒認識自己恩賜,和更具体地幫助他們發展恩賜。第二,這以 聖靈為主題的題目只在中文組(粵、國),而未能普及到英語組之中。因為聖靈為題在去 年英語組也曾引起熱烈的討論。去年與過往一樣,每週講道完畢,下週有講章摘要供教 友閱讀重溫。電子版可在教會網站下載或查閱。
- 2) 藉啓應文,每週有不同的說話來提醒教友注目耶穌,把敬拜焦點朝向祂。並有清楚的代 禱項目打印在投影片中,使教友明白當日禱告的事情。
- 3) 今年沒有定管家月。明年再安排一個月定爲管家月份。

家庭事工:

我們仍以家庭會客室 (每月一次) 來幫助不同家庭面對教導孩童上的困擾。再次多謝劉黎幗華姊妹忠心的服事。她不單預備充足,家長獲益良好,平均每次有 14 位家長參長。且在每月的會客室結束後,她也把講題重點以大綱式刊登出來與教友分享。這些題目都存放在教會網站之中。歡迎大家查閱。

福音佈道:

- 粵語組與短宣中心合作,借用他們的網上佈道活動,鼓勵教友向未信人士傳揚福音。我們也參加耶穌愛灣區活動。詳情請參閱佈道委員會的簡報。
- 2) 我們透過弟兄姊妹來幫助栽培初信者。他們從慕道,經個人交談,鼓勵認信,隨即安排 一位教友與他們做為期 3 個月的初信栽培;選用初信成長九課。這種一對一的方式,更 能幫助他們明白信耶穌是怎樣一回事。完結後,進而邀請他們參加由劉牧師主領的洗禮 班和堅振禮班(信徒成長班)。由於疫情緣故,各樣栽培形式以網絡進行,但仍不減參加 者渴慕追求的心。今年的經驗告訴我們,從初信到成長可有下面幾個步驟:首先,傳揚 福音;其次,一領一式初信栽培;接着,邀請參加洗禮班;跟着,學習信徒成長課程; 然後洗禮和堅振禮;最後,鼓勵邀請他們聚會和查經小組,週日一起敬拜神。

靈命塑造/信徒成長:

- 1) 12 月 26 舉行了本年度實体的洗禮和堅振禮。今年有 17 位接受洗禮; 21 位接受堅振禮。
- 2) 4月份復活節起推動一年讀經計劃,預料 2022 年 4 年完成。
- 3) 9 月起每月一次推行門徒訓練,名爲「使命門徒」訓練。到 2022 年 5 月才告完成。

2021 Cantonese ministry and activity report

Worship:

- 1) Last year, the church's theme was to focus on walking with the Holy Spirit in the time of the epidemic. We used the worship pulpit to teach several essential subtopics: "Distinguish all spirits," "Pray in the Holy Spirit," "Develop spiritual gifts," and "Enrich the spiritual life." There are two points worth reviewing. Firstly, on the topic of spiritual gift development, the church did not fulfill the role in leading our members to identify their gifts, and specifically to help them in spiritual gift development. Secondly, the topics with the theme of the Holy Spirit are only available in the Chinese-speaking group (CM and MM), but not in the English group (EM) which also had a hot discussion last year. Hope that we will do something in these two areas. On the other hand, we printed out a sermon summary every Sunday last year, which summarizes the message from the previous Sunday sermon, which is to help people review the key points of the message they had heard from the pulpit. The electronic version can be downloaded from or viewed on the church website.
- 2) Every week, we used the Introits to remind the church members to focus their worship on Him. And there were also prayer request items shown on the slides so that the church members will understand the prayers of the day.
- 3) We didn't have a stewardship month last year. We will resume it this year in September 2022.

Family and Parenting Ministry:

We are still using the monthly parenting workshop to support families as they face the challenges of teaching kids at home. We would like to thank our sister, Elizabeth Lau, again for her faithful service. The parents have found helpful in her teaching. There were, on average, 16 parents attending each month. And after the parenting workshop, Elizabeth would post the outline to share with the rest of the church members regularly. These topics are posted on the church website. All are welcome to read.

Outreach and Evangelism:

- 1) The CM group cooperated with the Short-term Mission Center, utilizing their online evangelistic activities, continue to reach out to the non-believers with the good news of Christ. We also participated in the "Jesus Loves Bay Area" annual event. Please see the Evangelistic Committee report for details.
- 2) With the help of our brothers and sisters, we cultivated the new believers through one-on-one follow-up. Through personal contacts, they helped the seekers to understand the

truth and encouraged them to confess their faith. This is followed with three months of 9 lessons of new believer cultivation. This one-on-one approach can help the new believers understand what it is like to be a Christian in Christ. After that, they were invited to participate in the baptism class and confirmation class (Growth in Christ course) led by Pastor Lau. Due to the pandemic, various spiritual formation courses are carried out online, but the participants' enthusiasm has not diminished. Last year the setting taught us that there are several steps to strengthen a Christian's faith from the beginning of faith to maturity: firstly, share the gospel with an unbeliever; secondly, lead one on one basic truth of faith; thirdly, invite to participate in baptismal class; fourthly, study the Grow in Christ course; fifthly, baptize and confirmation service; and last but not least, encourage and invite them to fellowship and Bible study groups, including the regular Sunday worship.

Spiritual Formation / Spiritual Growth:

- 1) The baptism and confirmation service were held on December 26, 2021. Last year, 17 were baptized; 21 were confirmed.
- 2) The one-year Bible reading plan was started on Easter last April, and it will be completed in April this year.
- 3) Discipleship training has been implemented once a month since last September. It is called "Mission Discipleship" training. We will continue the training until May 2022.

reflection. The ministry life of Lutheran Church of the Holy Spirit in 2021 could be framed by many famous quotes. "It was the best of times, it was the worst of times" (Charles Dickens). Looking back at my personal life and the life of our community of faith, certain moments I want to seal in cherished memory and others, I wish to have deleted from all records or to press the undo button to try again, yet I know that we live under the gracious and almighty hand of God. So it is good to tell life as it is with all its honorable and



dishonorable moments, so that all glory is returned to our Heavenly Father.

Life Finds a Way Forward

Much of 2021 was carefully navigating what could be as we still were mindful of Covid health protocols.

On a personal ministry level, it was a joy to guide three couples into their marriage celebrations with family and friends. The new experience for me was to guide an older couple, each having been in a previous marriage, yet being blessed by God to be united as a new husband and wife. What more could be discovered or taught in premarital counseling to people who have already been married? And for the other two couples, whom I've conducted their private marriage ceremony in 2020, what else could be said at the marriage celebration with family and friends in 2021? This is a humble reminder to me that when we have the "been there, done that" moments in life, God still graciously gives His love and blessing and supplies us with continued life. It's like Elijah blessing the widow's jars of flour and oil to last through the famine and Jesus' miracle of water becoming wine at the wedding feast in Cana.

We also had our moments of back and forth in the ministry of streaming online



worship during the first half of 2021. I'm very thankful for our worship leadership team to bring the best for the English Ministry and our Sunday English Service. As February rolled around, we were discerning how to bring people back into the church building for Sunday indoor or outdoor worship. Our discussions were almost contentious in the details of who can be masked or distanced or safe as we learning to serve in-person again. I appreciate the extra effort which our worship leadership team has done to try outdoor worship in the parking lot and assessing the organization and work which is necessary to do it well.

April and May 2021 was a trial and error period for live-streaming Sunday English services and having Sunday Service Teams work together in person. How can we live-stream from the church building with all our

gained skills? How can we do better than the previous year where we scrambled to bring our services online and adapt to members' feedback? Would gained insights be shared and adopted by other ministry groups? It was a time to live up to personal and people's expectations.


As June rolled around, I was thankful for the momentum which our church has accomplished. Sunday services were happening. Fellowships were continuing with online gatherings. Our HUG Preschool was celebrating a one year anniversary since relaunching in April 2020. But I was tired. Tired of paying attention to the next update in health protocol. Tired of having to respond to the "what's next?" In personal and ministry areas of life. Tired of having to keep everyone safe and well during this pandemic.

Re-visiting Sore Spots

In one of the most unique times in my years of pastoral ministry, I asked for and was blessed to take a month of vacation in July 2021. It has never happened before... a solid four weeks out of the office and particularly at that time of year, especially when everything is usually the most active for re-launching in-person worship and our Summer Day Camp activities. There was a mixture of guilt yet confidence that the church will carry on, yet the time away was most needed for me, personally and as a family.

Interestingly, July isn't and wasn't intended to be a mindless rest and relaxation to escape the troubles of this world. Although out of town, I was still involved

online in guiding our English Ministry had a team which was in the midst of the Leadership Pipeline training, which is intended for the well-being and sustainability of our ministries. It so happened that July's homework was to do a selfevaluation of our ministries.



And that was a difficult, honest, and revealing look in the mirror:

- What is lacking?
- What do I hate doing in ministry?
- · Why is it so?
- How could we adapt towards a better future?

I am thankful for that physical and existential space for my personal reflection on my life and for the team's reflection on our church life. Although hurtful, it is helpful to revisit trauma and see how we can continue to move beyond it in healthier ways. That is the life lesson which Paul encourages to the Philippian church to focus on.

Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus. Let those of us who are mature think this way, and if in anything you think otherwise, God will reveal that also to you. Philippians 3:13-15

Return and Renew



Fall 2021 was a significant shift for everyone in our community. For those with school age children, for us as a worshiping community of Cantonese/English/Mandarin groups, for expanding vaccination opportunities, for re-gathered youth fellowships... "let's see how we could have our life back." As we seek to regain much of what we have lost, I see it's a careful time to listen deeper and cherish the space of reevaluation.

Our church was prepared to call staff into the HUG Preschool ministry, yet over the course of 2021, the people had declined to serve in such capacity. This shift is worth mentioning because we are a church family which needs to be sensitive to one another and to learn how we each are and how God might be shaping us. I am thankful that our church staff and lay leaders are understanding and making the ministry changes to help as the body of Christ.

The eye cannot say to the hand, "I have no need of you," nor again the head to the feet, "I have no need of you." On the contrary, the parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and on those parts of the body that we think less honorable we bestow the greater honor, and our unpresentable parts are treated with greater modesty, which our more presentable parts do not require. But God has so composed the body, giving greater honor to the part that lacked it, that there may be no division in the body, but that the members may have the same care for one another. If one member suffers, all suffer together; if one member is honored, all rejoice together. 1 Corinthians 12:21-26

One of the deepest griefs for us as church family in early 2021 was to walk with a family after a member had died by suicide. This person had grown up through our youth ministries and we were as shocked as the family. We felt powerless with absence of this beloved person. The most precious times, before and during the funeral, was to sit, to be present, and to listen to those grieving. Despite all the questions which still remain, we have but the words of God to keep us together and to keep walking forward.

The challenges of 2021 remind me that we still have a ways to go as a community of faith. Are we really ok until we have the time and space to



tell each other what's really going on? What else is there besides thoughts and prayers? What does spiritual intimacy look like in a socially distant world?

The test will be proven by how we carry out Jesus' command for his disciples to love one another.



A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another. John 13:34-35

As we are walking through 2022, more unknowns and surprises will test us to the limits of our existence. Yet we could take heart as the disciples did at the end of the first Last Supper, because Jesus has overcome the world.

I look forward to encouraging the growth of our leaders and members on their upward calling in Christ and to discover what God has placed before us as a community of faith in San Francisco.

I am thankful for our Pastoral Team and

Council and Elders and HUL/SDC and HUG staff and committee and fellowship leaders who keep striving to reach people with the love of Christ. We live for Jesus to be Lord and Savior of all and that comes by God's faithfulness to us!

Year in Review 2021 by Evangelist Yongcheng Zhao (Barak)

Completion of studies

Thanks to God's guidance and the support of my family, I successfully completed my Master of Divinity and Master of Theology studies at Christian Witness Theological Seminary in May and December of 2021. The total study time was four and a half years, six months ahead of the required length.

Change of identity

Thanks to God's mercy and grace, I was able to complete my OPT application in October and November, which originally required a wait of three months or even more than six months. At the same time, I am grateful for the trust and support of the church, which ordained me as an Evangelist in December, and I officially became a full-time staff of the church in January 22.

Ministries

A large part of 2021 still was home isolation and online worship. However, compared to 2020, both the software and the equipment as well as the technical skill of the church staff have greatly improved, which has laid a good foundation for the simultaneous online and offline worship services that began in August. The Mandarin Ministry resumed offline worship services on August 15, and also conducted live YouTube streaming on cell phones. After a few months of improvement, we gradually changed to using Laptop OBS with cell phones and professional microphones for live streaming, bringing a more mature, stable and inexpensive live streaming solution (all of the above equipment is the original equipment of the church and my own equipment, except for the \$100 microphone, which is a new purchase). In addition, the Mandarin Ministry Sunday School also uses the same equipment to conduct live broadcasts online and offline at the same time, and the results are very good, for which we give thanks to God.

In addition, the Mandarin Ministry has been actively planning evangelistic outreach to families, international students and restaurant staff since the church reopened in August. Although the offline activities did not bear any further fruit due to the pandemic, we thank brother Sherwood and sister Weng Yun for helping us to plan the "Love and Family" series of workshops for couples in the Joy Fellowship.



The Crisis
As
A Turning Point

The period from early 2020 to late 2021 is an unusual time. With the global pandemic and the election that has shaken the United States, natural and man-made disasters have made our social environment, as well as the church environment, a crisis. Even the safest and most welcoming harbor, the family, is no longer absolutely safe.

But the grace of the Lord is always sufficient for us. Even when we think we are walking in the valley of the shadow of death, the Lord who loves us is always with us, and comforts us, guides us, and brings us to a turning point in the midst of crisis. Since the church decided to reopen in August of 2021, the number of people attending the church has decreased and the ministry has doubled, but the grace has doubled and so has our love for the Lord. Outlook of 2022

 - 2. Planning discipleship and spiritual growth programs in the MM.
- 3. Continue to lead the MM's weekly prayer meetings and daily prayer vigil
 - 4. Increasing the care of visits to brothers and sisters.
- 5.Continuing to use Annual Bible reading plan in Youversion with the church, and doing a good job of sharing daily spiritual food with my wife Deborah.
- 6.To cooperate fully with the church in the preparation of Worship for CM and MM.
- 7.After the pandemic has subsided, work with HUL and CM to organize more creative and attractive community evangelistic activities, such as hand-made nougat dispensing gospel leaflets, to spread the gospel in the community more often.
- 8. Cooperate with co-workers to promote online and offline family ministry through "Love and Family" to help more families unite and harmonize in Christ.
- 9.To cooperate with the requirements of the Lutheran District Council in completing various studies.

It is in the hands of the Lord to entrust the above plans with respect and hope that they will be fulfilled, adjusted, or abandoned.

另外,國語部也在8月教會重啟之後 積極策劃福音外展事工,包括社區家庭、 留學生事工和餐館員工等。儘管因為受疫 情影響,線下活動沒有取得進一步的成果 ,但是感謝 Sherwood 大哥與翁云姊妹幫 助我們在喜樂團契中成功策劃了"恩愛有 家"系列夫妻講座,期待22年該活動能夠 蒙上帝所使用和祝福。

The leadership development of Starburst Elite 2021

will engage in a relational, intentional, and focused training from the context of both the learner and leader.

When it comes to finding the best approach, I was reminded by one of my Fuller professor, Dr. Freeman. He said, "there isn't one best model, but all the aspects of the design need to be considered in order to create the best model." While knowing the fundamentals of what, why, where, and when are essentials, I believe the developmental approach of SDC's Starburst Elite must involve experiential learning in the context of apprenticeship or mentorship, where support, nurturing, and accountability are being mutually practiced. It's almost like the "Jesus' development, where Jesus, as the leader, and his disciples, as the learners, encounter the "rhythm of affirmation and confrontation, affection and demand" (Reese & Loane. Kindle Locations 2101-2102). Both parts of the teaching and training are important. In addition, a vital part of this training focuses in

"being," or who we are as a leader. What is the uniqueness, strength, family background, gifts.

One must-have characteristic any leader who chooses to participate in SBE is an ardent desire to be transformed in the presence of God. Leaders aren't to become mere information dispensers, but facilitators concerned about the cultivation of life transformation. This is to be first and foremost. "It is what we want for ourselves and it is what we want for those we are leading." (Reese & Loane, Kindle Location 2298). The type of leaders best suitable for SBE are young leaders who are "willing to go below the surface of things today, not in order to impress anyone but rather to be able to see and be more truthful and gracious (Reese & Loane, Kindle Locations 2329-2330).

Generational Asian-American families struggled considerably with distinctive issues such as guilt, shame, mistrust, identity

Many have chosen to suppress past pains, and yet waiting to meet someone to open up to. Leaders must be truthful and gracious. They continue to invite others by paying attention, listening, and asking questions patiently. Leaders are like farmers, who do not control the process, but rather participate in it. The farmer also "works well recognizes both the necessity and the modesty of his or her part in the whole. The posture is not one of control but of cooperating with the Maker of all things (Reese & Loane, Kindle Locations 2482-2483).

No one journeyed through life more beautifully the way Jesus did with others during his life and ministry on earth. Indeed, it is the best display of any leadership model or approach ever existed. Starburst Elite must imitate Jesus' relational and developmental way, which is deepening, particularizing, hospitable and patient.

The Church Council has reviewed and is happy to present the combined Financial Reports for the General Fund, HUL/SDC, and HUG Preschool. Detailed financial reports are available by request. The following are highlights of key financial information:

Church Council approved allocating \$30K from the year-end positive cash flow to restricted Building Fund to pay for anticipated building repairs.

Overall Comments

We praise the Lord for His guidance, despite we are still striving to cope with COVID, worship offerings have exceeded the pre-COVID level, they were \$629K in 2019 and \$610K in 2020. Tuition income in both HUL/SDC and HUG Preschool experienced significant decline in 2020 due to the pandemic, but are trending up in 2021. In 2022, we have increased staff to grow the church. We will be prudent in managing a tight budget. We are expecting COVID will linger on this year, and growth in the after-school and preschool ministries will be slow. On the other hand, we as a church have learned a lot over the past couple years in using technology to connect with people remotely, and how to keep everyone safe as we gather in person under the new normal.







Highlights 2021

In the past, the church sent various mission teams to visit the mission fields overseas, to support the missionaries, and to participate in their work and serve the locals. All these were halted because of the pandemic. However, the support for the missionaries and their gospel works did not stop.

We continue to keep close contact with our missionaries and support their ministry needs in the field. We are thankful for our members who faithfully support the mission financially. We can support two new missionaries, Juliana Mak who is serving at the UC Davis campus ministry. The other is Stella Yau who is serving LINC in South California.

Global and Local Mission are both important. The Bay Area Christian Short Term Mission Training Center held an evangelism workshop this June, named "Jesus Loves the Bay Area" for Bay Area churches. Mission and Evangelism Committees worked to motivate our members to participate in this great evangelism workshop. We had eight members who participated in this four day workshop. Our member, Kinh Tran's parents accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior during one of the telephone evangelism program. May all the glory be to our Lord Jesus Christ.

The 12th Annual Mission Conference – The Cantonese and Mandarin ministries held the conference from 10/8-9/2021. The theme was: "Mission 2.0: Missions under the New Normal". Rev. Timothy Chiu, founder of the Chinese Online School of Theology was the keynote speaker on Friday evening. On Saturday, Rev. Chiu along with two colleagues, who are highly experienced in media training, shared through Zoom from 7:30 to 9:30pm. The Mission Committee had invited several missionaries who are funded by our church to report on their local conditions during the pandemic. The English Mission Conference "Living in God's Loving Pursuit" was held on Friday 12/3 at 7:30 p.m. It's an in-person meeting and on YouTube. And on Sunday 12/5, Pastor Joe Robb was the keynote speaker in both English and Cantonese worships.

Although we have to put aside short term mission trips because of the pandemic, through online conferencing we can continue to care for and train overseas believer leaders. In August, Pastor Lau started to meet with Macau Christian leaders through Zoom to have Bible studies and training. In September, our church hosted a Catalyst leaders/discipleship Training monthly for nine months. The Macau believers were invited to attend together. Although there is a time difference, this did not stop them from responding to the Great Commission. There were six believers attending from Macau. The CMC Global 2021 was held on 12/28-29. The theme was "Faithful & Fruitful – Unleashed Together for God's Global Glory. We had more than 50 congregation members registered this year. May God ignite their passion for mission Locally and Globally.

Plans for 2022

- Mission Committee meet every two months using ZOOM, to follow up on missionaries' needs and to pray for them.
- The 13th Annual mission conference will be held in October tentatively.
- The Committee will invite supported missionaries quarterly to share with congregation members on knowing how to pray for their ministries.
- Continue to encourage congregation members to support and participate local and overseas mission work.
- May the Holy Spirit continue to ignite us to spread the good news to the lost.

2021 年事工分享

「上帝恩、宣教心」

2021年因疫情帶來的隔離,不安,憂慮,社會民生和經濟問題等等,隨着疫苗面世,生活常態慢慢恢復,國與國的邊界也恢復通關。似乎看到隧道的盡頭。但變種新冠病毒,仍然橫行全球,我們仍要加以提防和保護,不可掉以輕心。

深願透過今年宣教年會,講員們所分享的,激勵衆信徒在宣教上齊心參與和堅持,讓宣教之火繼續點燃我們各人的心。

由使者協會舉辦的全球華人差傳大會在 12 月 28-29 號線上 舉行, 共有 50 多位弟兄姊妹 參加。每天大會有不同的講座,使參加者認識了神在本地和全球所推動的善工和服侍的機 遇。





主任牧者的話(劉少銘牧師)

2022 年度聖工計劃安排和重點簡述如下:

教會繼續以:崇拜,佈道,靈修塑造,關顧,團契,和海外宣教為六個方向,使教會中每位教友能邁向成熟,取得平衡的教會生活。

本年度主題:

教會定本年度主題為:「重提、重建、重啓」(Remind, Rebuild, Reset)(註: 多謝 教會主席 Eddie 弟兄的建議,我採納他的主題作為今年度的主題)。教會預期 疫情好轉。雖然偶有緊張時刻,但社區人士已適應了與病毒共存。由此,我們將陸 續恢復不同的實體活動。並重新提醒弟兄姊妹教會生活的重要性和核心價值,包括 基礎的信仰,均衡的教會生活,和專一敬拜上帝等等。

崇拜:

- 1) 5 月份定為主題月:崇拜分享「重提,重建,重啓」這年度主題。
- 2)教會定今年九月爲管家月,並且在該月推行恩賜問卷調查和特別恩賜講座。協助弟兄姊妹發掘,發展和發揮自己的屬靈恩賜。

家庭事工方面:

- 1)配合國語組名為「恩愛有家」的每月家庭事工活動,每月第1星期日晚上有特別講座,由一對白人宣教士夫婦主持。當中,我們安排粵語傳譯,使粵語組弟兄姊妹得到幫助。6月份參加他們的「恩愛有家」夫婦營。
- 2) 家庭會客室:繼續每月最後一個星期四晚有家庭會客室,分享不同題目。

傳福音佈道:

1) 今年推出名為蒙恩小組的佈道小組,目的是以連續六次小組關懷佈道,使身邊的朋友和家人能夠認識耶穌,成為主的門徒。

靈命塑造/信徒成長:

1) 3 月份起至 6 月初有洗禮班,為打算在 6 月五旬節聖靈降臨日洗禮的新信徒提供。另一次在 7 月份至 10 月初另一次洗禮班,為打算在 12 月底聖誕期間洗禮的新信徒預備。

- 2) 10 月中至 12 月底,有信徒成長班/堅振禮班,為 12 月底聖誕期間接受堅振禮的弟兄姊妹預備。
- 3) 我們儘力協助每位新洗禮加入教會的新信徒,使他們有固定的團契/小組查經活動。並且每月至少一次參加教會崇拜和守聖餐。這兩項活動是教會生活靈命塑造重要部份。
- 4) 年中教會擬定一系列講座,名為「認識聖靈」。透過這系列講座,使信徒更明白靈恩運動的正反面。並分辨極端靈恩運動對正統信徒的危害。使我們重建聖經為本,和基督為中心的信仰生活。這系列講座預算以三次不同的題目進行。
- 5) 9 月份推動認識恩賜的講座。目的是幫助信徒發掘、發展、和發揮自己的屬靈 恩賜,榮神益人。
- 6)繼續使命門徒訓練(1月至5月)。以塑造信徒成爲使命門徒。
- 7) 今年推出一個領袖訓練的講座項目。目的是加強教會領袖和信徒健康的服事意識。使大家的服事更能祝福别人,祝福教會。

團契:

- 1) 恢復福音團契,以每月一次為準。以吸納太極班慕道者,和未有參加團契新信 徒。
- 2) 恢復活水團契,針對 25-35 歲的中文職青人士而設
- 3) 加強對 HUL 家長的外展,鼓勵他們參加教會的團契,例如: PBS 家長團契等。
- 4) 在團契 (AU, PBS, HOPE, Gospel等)推行關懷小組。使團契更有內聚性,使團友更有歸屬感。

目標和代禱項目:

- 1) 我們期望更多粵語組弟兄姊妹參加每月的教會禱告會
- 2) 我們期望在未來十年,能把粵語組年齡層降低十年。以其達到平均年齡爲四十歲左右。
- 3)我們預備為來年增添多一位中文部同工來協助粵語組事工,以舒緩和替補年事 已高的粵語組中堅服事的領袖。並啓動中文部同工牧者 (粵語組)未來數年間的 交替補換機制。
- 4) 我們期望本年固定崇拜人數能增加百分之十五。
- 5) 我們期望本年有十位人士成爲新信徒和本堂教友。

Words from Pastor Lau (Senior Pastor)

2022 Ministry plans

The 2022 annual ministry plan and highlights are briefly described as follows:

Every year, the church continues to focus on the six areas: worship, evangelism, spiritual shaping, care, fellowship, and mission so that every church member can move towards maturity and achieve a balanced church life.

This year's theme: Remind, Rebuild, Reset

The church has set the theme for this year as: "Remind, Rebuild, Reset" (Note: Thanks to brother Eddie, our church President, I adopted his suggestion as the theme of this year). The church expects the pandemic outbreak to subside and slow down this year. Though there have been occasional tense moments, people in the community have adapted to living with the virus. As a result, we will resume different in-person ministries and activities one after the other. Once again, I want to remind brothers and sisters of the importance and the core values of church life, including basic beliefs, balanced church life, dedicated worship of God, etc.

Worship:

- 1) We will designate May to focus on the annual theme: "Renew, Rebuild, Restart."
- 2) The church has set the stewardship month in September this year. We will carry out a spiritual gift inventory and survey during this month. The goal is to assist brothers and sisters in discovering, developing, and using their spiritual gifts.

Family and Parenting:

1) In coordination with the monthly family ministry activity, the Mandarin group has started a ministry called "Love and Home," which is set on every first week of the month. The featured speakers are an experienced missionary couple. Though this is focused on the Mandarin group, we also arranged Cantonese interpretation to help the Cantonese-speaking brothers and sisters. In the end, we will set a couples' retreat camp in June. It is open for MM and CM people.

2) Family Forum: Continue to have a Family Forum on the last Thursday night of every month to share different topics.

Outreach and Evangelism:

1) This year, an evangelistic group called "Grace in Christ" will be launched in April. The purpose is to conduct a series of the consecutive small group meetings to reach out to the unbelievers so that friends and family around us will know Jesus and become the Lord's disciples.

Spiritual Formation / Spiritual Growth:

- 1) Baptism classes are available from March to early June for new believers who intend to be baptized on the day of Pentecost in June. Another baptism class will be held between July and early October for new believers who intend to be baptized during Christmas this year
- 2) From mid-October to the end of December, there will be a course entitled "Growing in Christ" or confirmation class for brothers and sisters who will be confirmed on Christmas day this year.
- 3) We will assist our newly baptized believers to join the church, so that they have regular fellowship/group Bible study activities and attend church worship and communion at least once a month. These activities are essential in shaping their regular church life.
- 4) In the middle of the year, the church plans to have a series of lectures called "Knowing the Holy Spirit." Through this series of lectures, believers can better understand the pros and cons of the Charismatic Movement and to discern the dangers of the extreme charismatic teachings to the believers. Pray that it will help us to rebuild a Biblical, Christ-centered life of faith. This series of lectures will be broken down into three different topics.
- 5) Seminar to promote awareness of gifts in September, A Stewardship Month. The purpose is to help believers to discover, develop, and utilize their spiritual gifts, to glorifying God and benefiting others.
- 6) Continue Catalyst Discipleship training (January to May) to shape believers into mission-minded disciples.
- 7) Launch at least one leadership training seminar program this year. The purpose is to strengthen the healthy service consciousness of church leaders and serving believers. Make everyone's service more able to bless others and bless the church.

Fellowship:

- 1) Restore Gospel Fellowship to be held every third Saturday of the month. This fellowship is to recruit the Tai Chi class members and new believers who have not participated in any fellowship.
- 2) Restore Living Water Fellowship to adapt for the people around 25-35 years old (Young adult group)
- 3) Strengthen outreach to HUL/SDC parents and encourage them to participate in church fellowships, such as PBS parent fellowship, etc.
- 4) Implement small groups in each fellowship (AU, PBS, HOPE, Gospel, etc.). Make the fellowship more cohesive and enrich the fellowship members to have more sense of belonging.

Goals and Intercession Items:

- 1) We expect more brothers and sisters in the Cantonese group to participate in the monthly church prayer meeting this year.
- 2) We expect to reduce the age group of the Cantonese group by ten years in the next ten years. As a result, its average age will go down to around forty years old.
- 3) We are going to add another CM Pastoral Staff to assist the ministry of the Cantonese group in the coming year, so as to relieve and replace the senior leaders of CM ministry. It will also help to start a replacement plan or retirement plan for the pastoral staff in the next five to ten years.
- 4) We expect the number of regular worshipers to increase by 15% this year.
- 5) We expect ten people to become new believers and church members this year.
